


OUR PROGRESS

Our biggest wins throughout this process have been:

1. Increased understanding of the complex barriers faced by Opportunity Youth among county leaders from all sectors.

- 2. Robust partner engagement resulting in decreased information silos across sectors. Over 80% of partner agencies have senior-level involvement.
- 3. The launch of a collaborative, career development event for young adults called "Career Glow Up." The purpose of the event is to have intentional conversations with youth about the supports they need in taking the next step on their career journey.






WHAT WE LEARNED
